

- ★ A late activity bus will be available with a leave time of approx 3:20-3:30


Tutoring

- We will have specific tutors for core subjects, by grade level from 2:15-3:15 Monday through Thursday


Grading Policy



Students explore STEM careers connected to their interests and aptitudes while practicing STEM concepts that are key for career readiness.



Students learn programming concepts, computational thinking, and develop problem-solving skills and persistence. Along the way, they create computer programs including interactive games and creative projects they can share and play.








Beginning Art







Courses:

- ★ As 6th graders, students will have some required classes.
- ★ Each class is approximately 75 minutes long
 - Math 6/Accelerated Math 6/Double Accelerated Math 6
 - Full year course
 - ELA 6/Accelerated ELA 6
 - Full year course
 - Science 6/Accelerated Science 6
 - Full year course
 - PE OR Dance (*Computers has moved to 8th grade)
 - Full year



English:

- ★ You will come to English every day! Both A and B days.
- ★ We will read 3 in-class novels during the school year.
- ★ We will write informative, argumentative, and narrative essays.
- ★ We use Canvas, Actively Learn, Edulastic, and No Red Ink for our assignments and assessments.
- ★ We will participate in Socratic Seminars, debates, and have daily discussions about the text we are reading.
- ★ If students do not complete their work during the period, it will become homework.

Math:

- ★ Students have Math every day. (A-Days & B-Days)
- ★ Carnegie Learning is our primary Math curriculum which has 2 components, a consumable book & Mathia, which is the online component.
- ★ Edulastic is used for any online testing with Carnegie Learning.
- ★ Khan Academy (MAP Accelerator) is used weekly to show individual growth on MAP Test.
- ★ Daily classes include: bell ringers/warm-ups, instruction, group & individual practice, & at times homework if classwork is not completed in class.

Math:

- ★ There are several paths available to students for Math.
 - 1) 6th Regular to 7th Regular to 8th Pre-Algebra
 - 2) 6th ACC to 7th ACC to Algebra
 - 3) 6th DBL ACC to Algebra (7th) to Geometry (8th)
 - * Students are not locked into paths & are able to move throughout middle school & even into high school if they demonstrate mastery of the necessary skills.

Science:

★ Students will have science every other day for approximately, 70 minutes, which allows more time to complete investigations.

Lessons are Phenomenon based!

New program - Amplify!

Students will learn to think critically by: asking questions; designing investigations; collecting data; analyzing data; collaborating with peers; and helping decide where we need to go next in the

investigation of our phenomenon.

- Students will choose PE or Dance
 - If a student would like both, they should choose PE and then set
 Dance as one of their 2 elective choices.
- \star PE classes will be year-long, co-ed, and held every other day
- ★ Students are expected to dress out in their Faiss Middle School PE uniform everyday for class. Uniforms cost \$20.00
- ★ Please make sure that students bring deodorant with them to leave in their PE locker to use after every class.
- ★ Each student will be given their own PE locker and school supplied combination lock to use for the school year.
- ★ Format for PE classes:
 - All classes begin with a warm up and fitness block
 - Capture the Flag, Basketball, Hockey, Soccer, Kickball

Physical Education and/or Dance:

- ★ Students will choose PE or Dance
 - If a student would like both, they should choose PE and then select Dance as one of their 2 elective choices.
- ★ Beginning Dance will include:
 - Learning a variety of dance styles and their history (ballet, jazz, modern, hip hop, and social dance)
 - Learning the basics of choreography and working collaboratively to create dances
 - Performance Opportunities
